
The Faces of Unmet Need

More than 220 million women in the developing world, at different stages of their reproductive lives, have an unmet need for family planning.

About 1 in 6 women in Africa believes, often incorrectly, that breastfeeding women cannot get pregnant. 1 out of 4 women in Asia report concerns about side effects as a reason for not using modern contraceptives.
